Young Israel Shomrai Emunah, Kemp Mill Synagogue, and Silver Spring Jewish Center have formally endorsed the creation of a joint community support program to address the needs of members who are unemployed, underemployed, or whose jobs are threatened. Details of the program are attached.

A critical aspect of the program is an electronic database that job seekers will be able to use to network with shul members who could advise, recommend, and provide further contacts. **We can only build the database with information you provide in filling out the attached questionnaire. It is crucial that all shul members (both spouses separately) complete the attached "Employment Assistance Form" and return it ASAP as indicated on the form.**

Please note that the database will be secure and private (access password required) and all information will be kept in full confidence. In addition, once your networking information is included in the database, members in need of job networking will contact you directly via "blind email" without knowing your identity. You may respond and offer help where appropriate.

To be successful we need the input from all of you, including from members who are retired. We urge you to participate in this practical and important mitzvah.






